# People understood how to predict the weather, but did not understand the prophets' predictions about the Messiah.

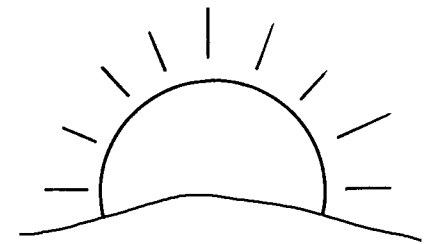
Use the letters in the clouds to complete the weather conditions on the left. Use the same letters in a different order to complete the predictions on the right. Each letter is used once on each side.



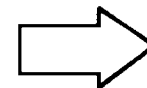
