#### **DEVOTION TO MARY HELPS US TO FOLLOW JESUS**

During my time here at St. Gall I have tried to keep one major goal in mind: forming disciples of Jesus Christ. In the end, that is why any parish exists. Recently, the Lord has put on my heart the need for our parish to follow Jesus with the help of the Blessed Virgin Mary.

To that end, I am encouraging everyone in our parish to spend the upcoming Lenten season preparing for Marian consecration.

There is a long tradition in the Church of seeking perfect union with Jesus through offering ourselves to Our Lady. Through baptism we are all called to holiness—to become saints as we follow Christ. St. Louis Marie de Montfort (1673-1716) called total consecration to Mary "the surest, easiest, and most perfect means" to becoming a saint. Through Marian consecration a person gives their body, soul, and the value of their good works and prayers—past, present, and future—to Mary to use and distribute as she wills. Mary is known as Mediatrix of All Graces. As the Mother of the Church she intercedes for the needs of all Christians and all of God's graces are distributed to the world through her. As St. Louis puts it, "the more a soul is consecrated to Mary, the more it is consecrated to Christ." We want to belong to Mary so that we can belong more perfectly to Jesus. Mary is our close companion as we follow Jesus.

Marian consecration is usually done through a prayer of consecration. A period of preparation before the prayer better opens our hearts to the grace of the consecration (this is also true of those who wish to renew their consecration). This Lent at St. Gall we will be using a new book by Christine Watkins called *Mary's Mantle Consecration: A Spiritual Retreat for Heaven's Help*. This book will cover a 46 day preparation period (the exact number of days from Ash Wednesday to Easter). The cover notes that this book is "for busy individuals, families, groups, and parishes." We all desire "Heaven's Help" for struggles in our own lives or in the lives of our families and friends. Marian consecration can help open up the floodgates of grace in our world. The four spiritual practices of Mary's Mantle Consecration are:

- 1. **The Rosary** Everyone is encouraged to pray this most powerful prayer every day.
- 2. <u>Fasting</u> In the Bible, God's people fasted before receiving his revelation (Exodus 34:28), or engaging in a great spiritual battle (Esther 4:16; Matthew 4:1-11) and as a way of repenting from sin (Jonah 3:5-9). Certain evil spirits can only be overcome by fasting (Mark 9:29). Through fasting we strip our focus on the desires of the flesh so as to be more open to life in the Spirit. Fasting is one of traditional practices of Lent, of course. The program recommends fasting (only bread and water) at least one day a week during the 46 days. The exact nature of the fast can be modified, however, based on one's unique health needs (self-denial is the main point).
- 3. <u>Contemplation of the virtues and the seven gifts of the Holy Spirit</u> By contemplating the virtues and the gifts of the Holy Spirit we open ourselves up to follow Jesus as Mary did. The *Mary's Mantle* book includes a brief reading for each day focusing on a particular virtue. The readings take only a few minutes! 46 virtues in 46 days (this is based on the 46 stars that are found on Mary's mantle on the sacred image of Our Lady of


Guadalupe). No saint embodied the virtues and gifts of the Holy Spirit better than Mary.

4. <u>Consecration to Mary</u> - Imagine not just "giving something up for Lent" but going through Lent with a well -defined path of contemplation and penance so that, as you come to Holy Saturday, you have experienced growth and transformation! You are more free to follow Jesus!We will have opportunities for parishioners to pray the prayer of consecration together on Holy Saturday and Easter Sunday.

The book is available through <a href="www.queenofpeacemedia.com">www.queenofpeacemedia.com</a> or on Amazon (both as a paper book or as an e-book). There is also a prayer journal available for those who would like that option. We will also have some resources for children and families to use. There will also be an option to receive the brief readings via a daily email. Stay tuned for more details in January and February.

We will start our Marian consecration preparation on Ash Wednesday (February 26) and ending on Holy Saturday (April 11).

#### ST. GALL CEMETARY NEWS

The columbarium in the St. Gall Cemetery is located in the northeast corner of the cemetery. There were recently two inurnments in our columbarium. There are 84 niches in the columbarium. Each niche can hold two standard sized urns of cremated remains. The cost for the niches are \$2000.00—\$2200.00 depending on the level. The niche markers are cast bronze for an additional cost of \$600.00.

We have a new infant cemetery space located next to our columbarium in our St. Gall Cemetery. This is an area reserved for miscarriages, stillbirths, and infant remains. A modest donation could be given for the cemetery plot and the interment. As with the full size grave sites, the family is responsible for any cost associated with the purchase and placement of a grave marker.

# 2019 St. Gall Conference of St. Vincent de Paul Annual Report

#### Who We Are

In the tradition of its founder, Blessed Frédéric Ozanam, the Society of St. Vincent de Paul leads women and men to grow spiritually through person-to-person service to those in need and suffering. Your St. Gall Conference of the St. Vincent de Paul Society is one of 4,400 conferences in the U.S. and 44,600 conferences in 150 countries worldwide.

#### What We Do

The members of our local conference donate their time and talent in fundraising events like Donut Sundays, St. Nicholas Breakfast, the St. Gall Cookbook and a Walk for the Poor. Then they visit individuals or families in need in the greater Elburn area to help determine their needs and how we can best assist them. Once a month, members also assist at the Elburn Countryside Food Pantry by picking up food at Jewel and delivering it to the pantry. In 2019, our Vincentians also provided a dinner for the Society's Hope Takes Action Program, a specially designed class to help the poor help themselves move out of poverty.

#### What We Accomplished This Past Year

During the fiscal year ending September 30th, 2019, the 23 men and women that make up the St. Gall Conference made 33 home visits to the needy, helping 79 people; by paying for Com Ed and NiCor Gas bills, mortgage, home repairs, Village of Elburn utility bill, rent payments, security deposit, temporary housing, health insurance, medical expenses, emergency food, car repairs, car loan and insurance, phone, and vehicle gas. None of this would be possible without the generous financial support of St Gall parishioners. **Thank you!** Here is a summary of the 2019 Annual Report for SVdP:

#### **The Elburn Countryside Food Pantry**

Some parishioners have asked what are the food pantry slips and where does the returned food go to?

Elburn is blessed to have the Elburn Countryside Food Pantry. The food pantry is a non for profit organization that started in 1987. The pantry was created to serve the Kaneland School District of Northern IL. The pantry is run by volunteers and it is located in the Elburn Community Center. St. Gall Church is one of five local churches that volunteer at the pantry each month. On the third weekend of each month, a basket of small slips of paper, each indicating an item needed for the pantry, is placed in the narthex for parishioners to take as they leave Mass. The items are then purchased and returned to church the following weekend. Jim and Darlene Biggs, who have been involved in this ministry for quite some time, load the items in their truck and take them to the food pantry. These items are then available for those in need. The pantry relies solely on donations, monetary or non perishable, to operate. 
